



First Italian Car Grand Prix Centenary AWARD

The A.R.I. branch of Brescia, in cooperation with l'Historic Racing Club Fascia d'Oro (club ASI 321), issue an AWARD to celebrate the 100th anniversary of the first Italian Car Grand Prix Race run in Montichiari (BS) on sept 1921.

The award will take place during the two central weeks of September, from Saturday 11 to Sunday 26.

To achieve the Diploma, the OM and SWL must work / listen the Italian activator stations located along the peninsula from 11 to 26 of September until the achievement of the following scores:

100 points for the Italian stations

50 points for the European stations

30 points for Extra-European stations

Some Jolly Stations will be active during the period:

"IQ" prefix Club stations

II2GP Super Jolly Station

Score:

1 point for each QSO with OM activating with their own callsign.

3 points for each QSO with "IQ" Jolly stations.

5 points for each QSO with the Super Jolly station II2GP

Bands: all HF bands.

Modes: CW, SSB, Digi.

The same station can be worked once a day per mode and per band.

Log: must be sent by October 30th 2021 via e-mail to the diploma manager – IZ2FOS Lorenzo Mendini: iz2fos@aribrescia.it.

The diploma will be issued for free in .pdf format and sent to the contestant after the 15 of November 2021.

The top scorers in each category - Italians - Europeans - EXTRA Europeans (Hunters who asked for the Diploma) and -Activator stations will be awarded with a little prize. The ranking will be published on the ARI Brescia website "www.aribrescia.it"
